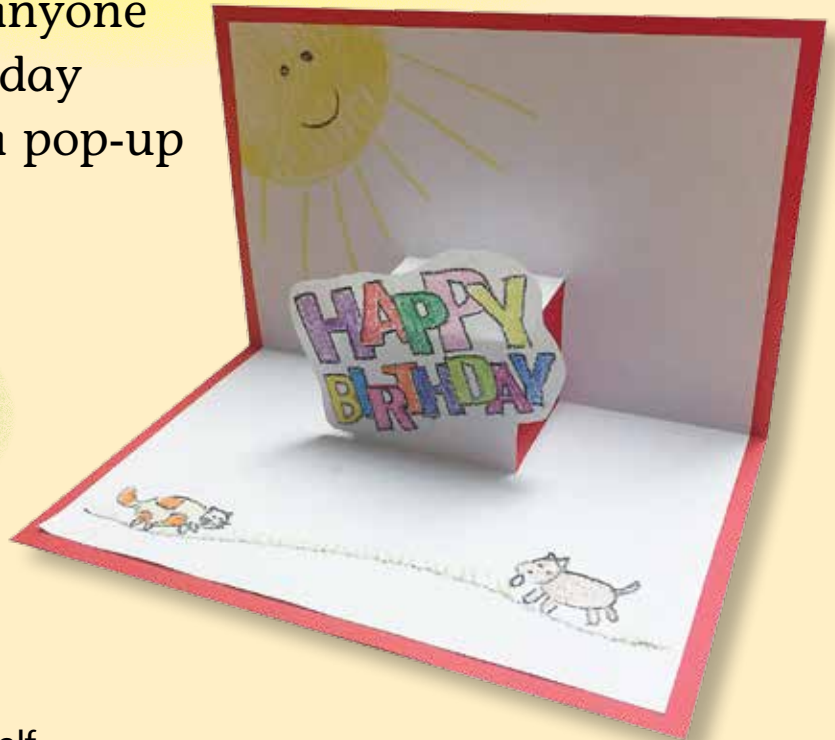


How to Make a Pop-up Birthday Card

1 If you don't know anyone celebrating a birthday now, you can make a pop-up holiday card instead.

What you need

Paper Scissors
Glue Crayons

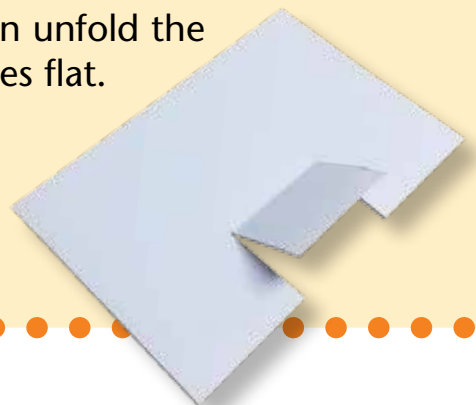


What you do

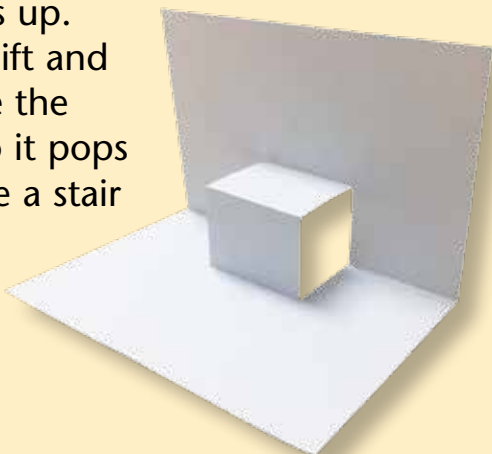
1. Fold a piece of paper in half, and draw two straight lines from the folded edge. The lines should be the same length, between one and two inches long, and an inch or two apart.



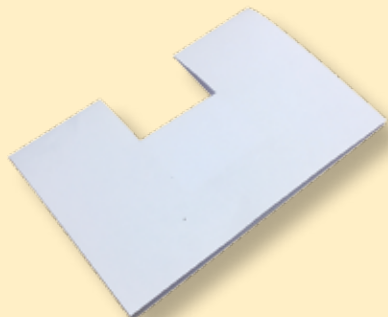
2. Cut along the lines, and fold the tab you have made back and forth. Then unfold the tab so it lies flat.



3. Open your piece of paper so one half lies flat and the other stands up. Now lift and crease the tab so it pops up like a stair step.



5. Close the piece of paper along the fold again, this time with the pop-up tab folded inside.



4. Glue or tape a picture or shape to the pop-up tab. The bottom of the picture should line up with the bottom of the tab. If you like, write some words or draw more pictures around your pop-up.



6. If you want more pop-ups, just add more tabs. Then fold another piece of paper in half and glue it to the outside of your pop-up page.



7. Decorate the outside of your card. Open the card, and watch your pictures pop!
