Forever Sandcastles

ALL OF US buggies love to make sandcastles in the summertime . . . but we like to see them all year round! Here's a cool way to keep your summer treasures.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:



3 cups sand (from beach, if legal in your state, or bought at hardware store)



old cooking pot



newspaper



old large spoon



seashells, stones, etc. (optional)

1 ½ cups cornstarch



1 ½ cups water



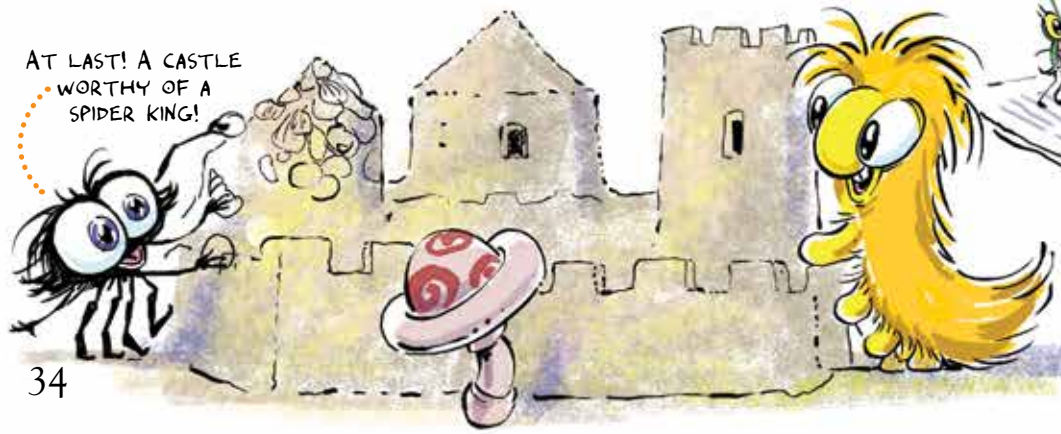
plastic sandcastle mold and nonstick cooking spray (optional)

WHAT TO DO:

1. Mix sand, water, and cornstarch in pot. With an adult's help, cook over low heat, stirring constantly.
2. When mixture is thick, take pot off stove and let mixture cool.
3. Spoon mixture onto newspaper.
4. Make a sandcastle (or other object) with sand mixture. If sandcastle mold is used, spray mold with nonstick cooking spray before adding sand mixture.
5. Decorate castle with seashells or stones.
6. Let dry.
