

CELEBRATE EARTH DAY with these colorful cookies. Spread the Earth Day spirit by walking or biking to a friend's house—with cookies to share!



- With a grownup's help, preheat the oven to 375°F.
- Divide the dough into two balls, one larger than the other, and place each in a mixing bowl.
- Add blue food coloring to the larger dough ball. Mix, adding more food coloring if necessary. Repeat with the green food coloring and the smaller dough ball.*
- To make the cookies: pinch off about a tablespoon of blue dough. Add one or more pieces of green dough and roll into a ball. Place two inches apart on baking sheet and gently flatten with the bottom of a glass.
- Bake for 6 to 8 minutes, or until set. Remove from baking sheet, let cool, and enjoy!
 - *Tip: If the dough gets too soft after mixing in the colors, refrigerate it for 30 minutes.





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
