Electrical tape in your favorite colors or team colors



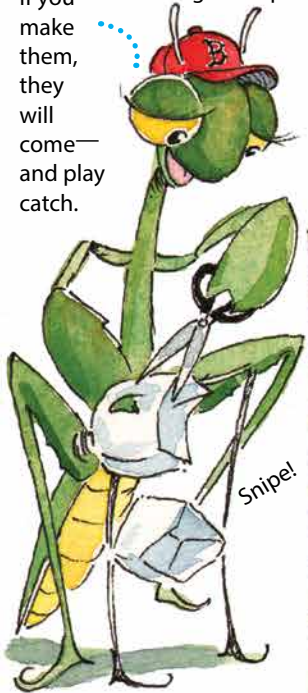
Ball
