MINI RECYCLED CHRISTMAS TREE

HERE'S A FUN recycling project that will put old magazines to good use just in time for Christmas!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

old magazine craft foam glue gun tape pompoms

WHAT TO DO:

- Fold down a page of the magazine so that its top edge meets the spine, as in the illustration.
- 2. Then fold again.
- **3.** Now fold up the bottom of the page to align with the bottom of the magazine.
- **4.** Repeat these steps until all the pages are folded, including the covers.
- 5. Tape together the back and front covers of the magazine. Cut out a star shape from the craft foam and glue to the top of the tree. Decorate using pompoms as Christmas balls.

Use thicker magazines to make a fuller tree, or you can tape together the front and back covers of two thinner magazines before you begin folding. Of course, don't try this with your issues of *Cricket*. That's one magazine you'll want to save for many Christmases yet to come!
