

# Happy Fall Faces

Turn these grinning pumpkin and cheerful ghost prints into cards for your friends or a banner for your bedroom.

## What You'll Need:

- washable tempera paints
- paper plates
- black construction paper
- potato, sliced in half

## What to Do:

1. With a grownup, pour white paint onto one paper plate and orange onto another. (If you don't have orange paint, try mixing red and yellow together.)
2. To make a pumpkin print, dip the smooth side of the sliced potato into the orange paint. Press it against the construction paper. If you want to turn it into a jack-o'-lantern, you can paint or draw a face on it after it dries.
3. To make a ghost print, dip your hand in the white paint. Press it against the construction paper. When it dries, you can paint or draw a face on it, or anything you would like.
