

# Recycled Magazine Holder

This Earth Day, stash your Spider magazines in style!

## What You'll Need:

empty cereal box at least 11  
inches tall and 8 inches wide  
pen  
ruler  
scissors  
recycled paper (like magazine  
pages, newspaper, wrapping  
paper, postcards, or photos)  
glue

## What to Do:

1. Cut off top of cereal box.
2. Make a mark halfway across the top of box, and another mark about 5 inches up from the bottom. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line to connect the two marks.
3. Cut down your diagonal line, cut straight across the spine, then cut back up the other side of the box at the same diagonal angle.
4. Gather your paper, scissors, and glue and start decorating. You can cover your holder with one type of paper or layer on different kinds to make a collage.
