

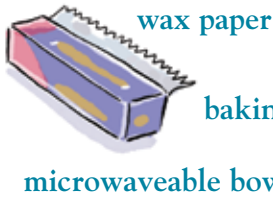


# Shamrock Pretzel Pops



SHAMROCKS ARE THREE-LEAFED clovers that grow all over Ireland. They're also a symbol of Irish culture, and of St. Patrick's Day!

## What You'll Need:



## What to Do:

1. Spread wax paper on a baking sheet.
2. Pour white chocolate chips into the bowl. Heat in the microwave for 20 seconds, then stir with a fork. Repeat until all the chocolate chips are melted.
3. Add green food coloring a few drops at a time. Stir well.
4. With fork, dip a pretzel into the chocolate so it gets completely coated. Lift the chocolate-covered pretzel out and lay it on the wax paper. Repeat with two more pretzels, laying them next to the first one in a shamrock pattern. Make sure they touch.
5. Dip the end of a lollipop stick into the chocolate and place it in the middle of the pretzel shamrock. Add sprinkles.
6. Repeat to make more shamrock pops. Refrigerate for three hours or until chocolate is hard, then enjoy. *Sláinte!*
